

Remote Learning Update at Swift Creek High School

Starting Monday **January 18th**, new rules regarding remote learning at Swift Creek High School will be in effect. The changes are as follows:

- Students may still Zoom into class as before if they are experiencing symptoms of COVID-19, have tested positive, or have been exposed under the following conditions:
 - A parent or guardian calls the school to inform the school the student will be participating over Zoom that day due to the reasons listed above.
 - In order for the absence to be excused, the student **must provide documentation from a medical professional** verifying that they were sick or have tested positive.
 - When an individual tests positive, they will receive a letter from WDH. If a student voluntarily discloses a known exposure to the school, the student **must acquire a copy of the letter sent to the individual who tested positive as proof of exposure**. At this time, the student must participate in class over Zoom for 10 calendar days. The absences will not be excused without the letter verifying the exposure.
