

Community Scholarship applications are now available! Please read the information below **carefully** so you don't miss any important steps or deadlines.

Where to Find Applications

All Community Scholarship applications are posted on the LCSD2 Foundation website.

1. Go to lcsd2foundation.org/scholarships
2. Find **Swift Creek High School**
3. Click "**View Scholarships**" under Swift Creek High School
Be sure you select Swift Creek High School only. Each school has different scholarships, and you are only eligible for SCHS scholarships.
4. This will take you to a Google Drive with all available applications.

How to Apply

- Download each application and review the eligibility requirements.
- Complete the application fully.
- If a transcript is required:
 - Download it from your **Infinite Campus account**.
 - Attach it to your application (do not email it separately).
- Applications must be **typed**, not handwritten.
- To fill out PDFs:
 - Download and save the file to your computer.
 - Open it in Preview and use the fill-in tools.
 - If you need help, stop by and chat with Robbie or Cheri.

Submitting Applications

- Email completed applications to: **lcsd2ef@lcsd2.org**
- You may email applications one at a time or send several together.
- All materials (application, transcript, essay, etc.) must be combined into **ONE PDF**. Separate files will not be accepted.

Important Information

- Scholarships are added regularly, so check lcsd2foundation.org/scholarships and your **student email** often.
- Many applications are similar, but some are different—be sure to use the correct form and answer every question.
- Community Scholarships are paid directly to your college or university after proof of enrollment (unless otherwise specified).
- You have **3 years after graduation (through June 30)** to use community scholarships.
- **Deadline: April 6**
No late applications will be accepted. Since this is the day we return from Spring Break, it is strongly recommended that you submit applications **before Spring Break**.
